Applications Now Being Accepted for 2010 Douglas County Fair Board Positions

As part of Ak-Sar-Ben's River City Rodeo and Stock Show, the Douglas County Fair Board is comprised of volunteers appointed by the Douglas County Commissioners.

Each Douglas County Fair Board Member's responsibilities include attending monthly meetings, securing sponsorships for the River City Rodeo and Stock Show, actively solicit fair entries, participate in the Douglas County Fair, and serve as general promoter and public relations liaison for the River City Rodeo and Stock Show.
